Page 1 of 4 Sexual Assault Statistics Approximately 19 million adult Texans (1,479,912 female and 372,394 male) of 126% of Texans have been sexually assaulted at some time in their lifetime1 One in 5 Texas women and 1 in 20 Texas men have been the victims of sexual assault2 Only 18% of victims report their assault to law enforcement
